Lodi	Early July	Tart	B C	Crisp, rich taste and soft texture, great for applesauce
Pristine	Mid July	Sweet & Tart	E	Sweet eating apple, Excellent for eating, cooking and sauce
Zestar	Mid August	Sweet & Tart	B C E	Crisp, rich taste and soft texture, great for applesauce
Summer Rambo	Mid August	Tart	B C	Good for pies & applesauce, best cooking apple of the summer
Gala	Late August	Sweet	E	Rich, full flavor, best for eating
Blondee	Early Sept	Sweet & Tart	E	Firm, crisp, does not bruise easily, slow browning, long storage life
Honey Crisp	Early Sept	Sweet	E	Cross of Macoun and Honeygold, crunchy and delicious
Day Break Fuji	Mid Sept	Sweet & Firm	E	Crisp & juicy, delicious snack and salad apple
Cortland	Mid Sept	Mildly Tart	B E	Good for salads, does not darken when cut
Macoun	Mid Sept	Mildly Tart	B C E	Firm & juicy, like its parent, McIntosh
Jonathan	Mid Sept	Tart	B C E	Great pie apple, also good for applesauce and juice
Crimson crisp	Mid Sept	Sweet & Tart	E	Firm, crisp, crunchy, great for eating, stores well
Crimson Gold	Mid Sept	Sweet & Tart	C E	Crisp, firm, juicy, good for eating and cooking, retains shape & texture in cooking
Golden Delicious	Mid Sept	Sweet	B C E	Excellent snacking, one of the most popular varieties in the world

Empire	Late Sept	Sweet	B E	Cross of Red Delicious and McIntosh, good all-purpose apple
Jonagold	Late Sept	Slightly Tart	B C E	Cross of sweet Golden Delicious and tart Jonathan
Ambrosia	Early October	Sweet	E	Crisp and Sweet, Best Flavor
Crispin	October	Sweet & Juicy	C E	Excellent dessert apple, also know as Mutsu
Cameo	Mid October	Sweet Tart	B C E	Chance seedling discovered in a Washington orchard in 1980's
Ida Red	Mid October	Slightly Tart	B C E	Excellent pie apple
Nittany	Mid October	Mildly Tart	B C E	Cross of Golden Delicious and York Imperial
Stayman Winesap	Mid October	Fairly Tart	B C E	Crisp & juicy, great all-purpose apple
Arkansas Black	Late October	Tart	B C E	Firm, crisp, multipurpose apple, dark peel, pale yellow flesh. Similar to Winesap.
Fuji	Late October	Sweet & Firm	E	Crisp & juicy, delicious snack and salad apple
Granny Smith	November	Tart & Juicy	B C E	Great baking apple, also good for sauce and juice
Evercrisp	November	Sweet	B C E	Crunchiest apple, Keeps well
Pink Lady	November	Sweet Tart	B C E	Crisp & tingly taste, firm texture holds up in cooking
Gold Rush	November	Sweet	B C E	Crunchy, aromatic, high sugar content, keeps well
